



### Racial Demographics




With less than half of the population choosing “protestant” as their religious preference, this area is in great need of the gospel.

Castle Hills Commons, located near city hall, provides a walking trail, green space, and community events.

The Castle Hills Woman's Club volunteers in many city-wide events, including the tree lighting ceremony, school bookfairs, and Fiesta Castle Hills.
