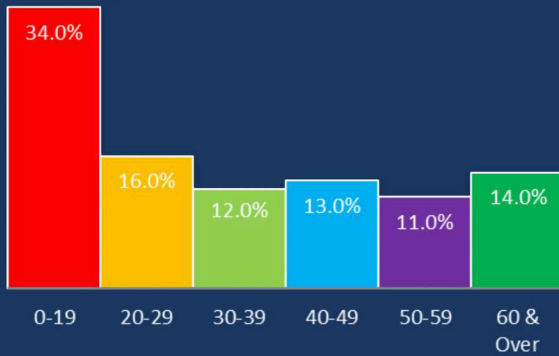

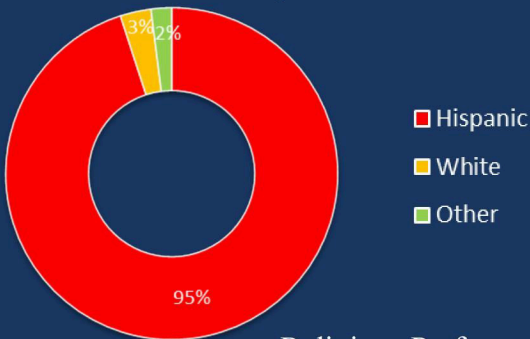

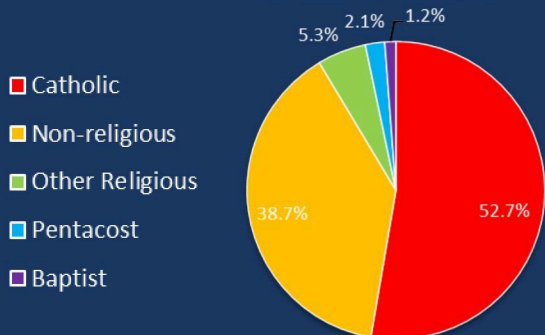


Racial/Ethnic Diversity

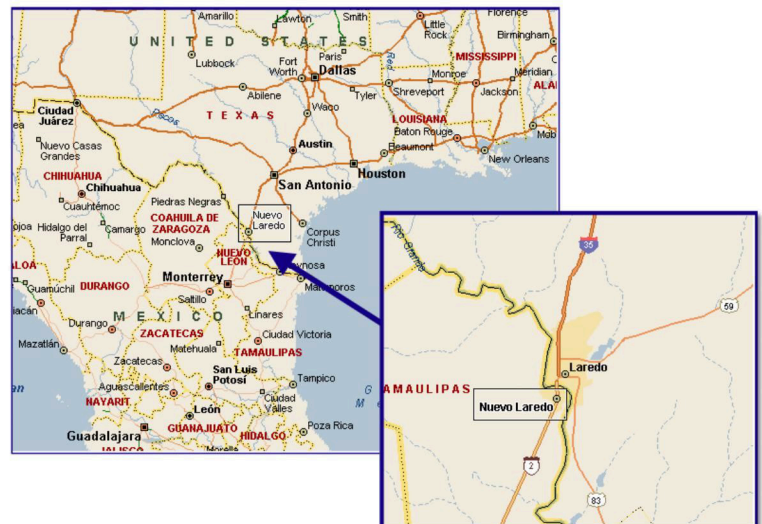
Laredo, Texas is the largest and most active port of entry to the United States in the Rio Grande Valley.

Laredo has a dominant Hispanic influence with a large middle class and a much larger working class, but many have low incomes and there is considerable poverty or near-poverty conditions.

Laredo is a largely Catholic city that is in need of reformed churches. With over 90% of the people in Laredo identifying "none" or "Catholic" as their religious preference, this area is in great need of the gospel.

Because we live, work, and worship within these communities, the people of the South Texas Presbytery and the Reach South Texas (RST) Church Planting Network are able to address the specific needs of newly planted churches in the area.

RST is committed to planting a church in Laredo that is soaked with Gospel life so that it embodies God's grace in worship, community and mission.

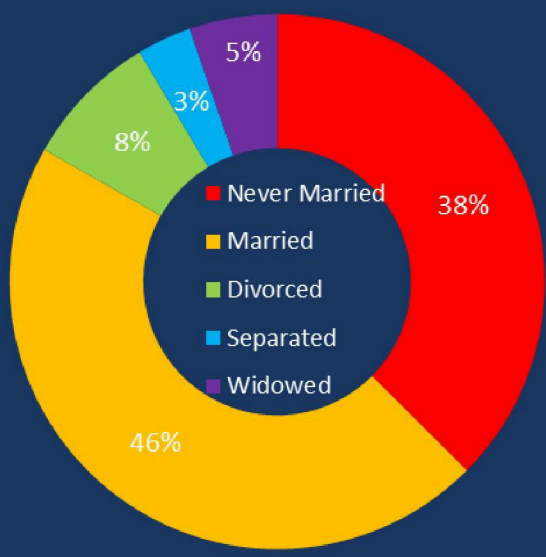
